"What is God Like?" - Lesson 2 - 3-in-1 - Father

Here are answers to the questions we asked on the video for this lesson. The answers are in red.

Psa 68:5 calls God, "Father of the fatherless"

# **QUESTION 1**

- Who are the fatherless and who is God to them?
  The ones without a father. God is their Father.
- Can the fatherless call God, Father? YES!

**2 Cor 6:18** says: "I will be a father to you, and you shall be sons and daughters to me," says the Lord Almighty.

### **QUESTION 2**

- Who does GOD say He is if we believe in Him? Our Father
- Who are we to God the Father? His sons and daughters
- Can you and I call God, Father? Yes!

Jeremiah 31:9 says: "I am a father to Israel,"

### **QUESTION 3**

- Who was God to the people of Israel? A Father
- Can the people of Israel call God, Father? YES!

**Rev 4: 2-3 (NKJV)** says: "behold" meaning LOOK!, a throne set in heaven, and One sat on the throne. <sup>3</sup> And He who sat there was like a jasper and a sardius stone in appearance ...

#### **QUESTION 4**

- What did God the Father look like to the Apostle John? Shining like a shiny jewel or like a jasper and sardius stone (jewel/gem)
- Where was GOD? Sitting ON a throne IN heaven

**Psa 103:13** says: As a father shows compassion to his children, so the LORD shows compassion to those who fear him.

#### **QUESTION 5**

 What does God give those who fear Him? His compassion, meaning His love and kindness

John 3:35 says: The Father loves the Son and has given all things into his hand

### **QUESTION 6**

How does Father God feel about Jesus? He loves Him

**1 John 3:3** says: See what great love the Father has lavished on US, that we should be called children of God!

#### **QUESTION 7**

- What kind of love does the Father have? Great, very MUCH love
- Who does the Father love? US you and I
- What does it mean to "lavish" your love on someone? To freely shower or pour your love upon them
- Who has Father GOD lavished HIS love on? His children

**Isaiah 64:8** says: But now, O LORD, you are our Father; we are the clay, and you are our potter; we are all the work of your hand.

# **QUESTION 8**

- Who is God to you and I? Our Father
- Who made us? God

**1Cor 8:6** says: yet for us there is one God, the Father, from whom are all things and for whom we exist

# **QUESTION 9**

- Who do we exist FOR? For God Himself
- Where do ALL things come FROM? From God, our Father
- What name could we give the Father <u>who made us</u> and who all things come from?

John 5:21 says: For as the Father raises the dead and gives them life

#### **QUESTION 10**

- Who is able to give life to the dead? God the Father
- How much power does He need to give life to the dead? All the power, the most power, the greatest power
