Lesson 2 What is a Follower of Jesus

Following is a copy of one of the Activity sheets from our Return of Jesus course. We want to give our children many opportunities to respond to the gospel message.

Becoming a Christian

<p>ADMIT YOU ARE A SINNER</p> <p>For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God Rom 3:23</p> <p><i>For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that <u>whoever believes in Him</u> should not perish but have everlasting life John 3:16</i></p>	
<p>JESUS DIED FOR US</p> <p><i>But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us Rom. 5:8</i></p> <p><i>All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all! Isa. 53:6</i></p>	
<p>BELIEVE</p> <p><i>That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved Rom. 10:9-10</i></p>	
<p>REPENT</p> <p><i>He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy Prov 28:13</i></p> <p><i>...Jesus came to Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel Mark 1:14b-15</i></p>	
<p>PRAY AND ASK</p> <p><i>And it shall come to pass, That whoever calls on the name of the LORD Shall be saved Acts 2:21</i></p>	
<p>Testify (tell) of JESUS</p> <p><i>That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. Rom 10:9-10</i></p>	

Simple Way To Pray:

Parents, teachers, mentors, please note: your child does not have to pray a specific word-for-word prayer. It is far better for your child to pray from their heart, even if they don't get all the words right. The basic idea is:

Admit your sin → **Believe** Jesus died for you → **Repent** of your sin and confess it. Repent with your words, your heart and your actions. → **Pray** and ask for forgiveness. Receive forgiveness because Jesus has promised to forgive you. → **Testify** of Jesus (tell others about Him).

Remember: we are talking *to* Jesus when we pray

Something to do:

Write down or record your story about how you became a follower of Jesus (a Christian). Keep it in a safe place so that you can remember this special day.

When you look at it, why not respond to Jesus again? Tell Him you still believe, still repent, and still want to follow and obey Him.
