"What is God Like?" - Lesson 2 - 3-in-1 - Father

Here are answers to the questions we asked on the video for this lesson. The answers are in red.

Prov 3:12 (NKJV) says: For whom the LORD loves **He corrects, Just as a father** the son (or daughter) in whom he delights.

QUESTIONS

- When God the Father corrects us, why does He do it? Because He delights in us, His children.
- How does He feel about us when He is correcting us? He feels love

John 14:26 says: the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name

QUESTION:

• Who SENT the Holy Spirit to help us? God, the Father

John 20:21: Jesus said, "As the Father has sent me.."

QUESTION

Who sent Jesus? God, the Father

Matt 6:26 says: Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet **your heavenly Father feeds them**. Are you not of more value than they?

QUESTIONS:

- Who feeds the birds? God, the Father
- Is God the Father able to provide for US? Yes!
- Is He able to take care of us? Yes
- Why do we KNOW this? Because the Bible says we are more valuable than the birds and the Father feeds them, so of course, He would feed/provide for/take care of us.

Jas 1:17 says: Every **good gift and every perfect gift** is from above, coming down from the **Father of lights**, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change.

QUESTIONS:

- Where does EVERY good and perfect gift come from? From God, the Father
- Does God the Father change in his thoughts and feelings toward you? Never
- How does this make you feel? You answer this
- What kind of Father must He be to give GOOD and perfect gifts? He must be a GOOD Father

Psalm 103 verse 13 – It says, "As a father **shows compassion** to his children, so the LORD shows compassion to those who fear him."

QUESTIONS:

- When has God shown you compassion? Your personal response
- When has He given YOU kindness, love or mercy? Your personal response

Jas 1:17b with the Father, " there is no variation or shadow due to change"

QUESTIONS:

- Does God our Father change? NO
- Will He ever STOP being a giver? No, never

John 4:23 which says: true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him

QUESTIONS:

- What is the Father seeking or looking for? True worshippers, or, those who will worship Him in spirit and in truth.
- Are you someone He will find? Your response

Matt 6:9. Jesus said, "Pray then like this: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name (meaning, may your name be honored as holy).

QUESTIONS:

- Who do we mostly pray to? God, the Father
- What does this verse tell us about the Father's name? His name is holy and we are to respect and honor His name
- Have you ever prayed to God the Father? Your response
