As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love John 15:9	<i>Thank you Jesus, that you love me just as the Father has loved you.</i> <i>Please help me to abide in your love.</i>
And I have declared to them Your name, and will declare <i>it</i> , that the love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them." John 17:26	<i>Thank you Lord, that you have asked the Father for the same love He loves you with, to be in me.</i> <i>I receive your love.</i> <i>Would you show me more about how you love me?</i>
"I will not forget your word" Psa 119:16b	<i>Help me, Lord, to never forget your word.</i>
How sweet are your words to my taste. Sweeter than honey to my mouth.. Psa 119:103	<i>Lord Jesus, let the words of the Bible be sweet to my taste.</i> <i>Please help me to love your words in the Bible</i>
He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I <i>will be</i> with him in trouble; Psa 91:15a	<i>Thank you Lord that you will answer me when I call out to you.</i> <i>Thank you for promising to be with me in times of trouble. I believe it!</i>
For the LORD <i>is</i> good; His mercy <i>is</i> everlasting, Psa 100:5	<i>Thank you Jesus for your goodness and mercy.</i> <i>You are good all the time and in every place</i> <i>I receive your mercy</i>
