Prayer Course Lesson 7 – Types of Prayer: Adoration



This week's activity has three steps:

1. Speak some things **about** the Lord; tell somebody in your family what He is like; for example:

- God is good
- God is ALL powerful
- God is holy

2. Turn these three statements into adoration prayer; and speak to God, for example:

- *God you are good*
- *God you are all-powerful*
- *God, you are holy*

3. Say the same adoration prayer as you just did, but also say more. Tell the Lord WHY you are adoring this part of His nature. Here are some examples:

- *God you are so good; you are good to me. I love your goodness!*
- *God you are all powerful; you are able to keep my family safe.*
- *God you are Holy and by the power of the Holy Spirit, you make me holy too. Thank you!!*
