<p style="text-align: center;"><b>REPENT</b></p> <p><i>He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy <b>Prov 28:13</b></i></p> <p><i>...Jesus came to Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel <b>Mark 1:14b-15</b></i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Testify (tell) of JESUS</b></p> <p><i>That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.</i></p> <p><i>For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. <b>Rom 10:9-10</b></i></p>

#### Simple Prayer To Pray:

Parents, teachers, mentors, please note: your child does not have to pray a specific word-for-word prayer. It is far better for your child to pray from their heart, even if they don't get all the words right. The basic idea is:

**Admit** your sin → **Believe** Jesus died for you → **Repent** of your sin and confess it. Repent with your words, your heart and your actions. → **Pray** and ask for forgiveness. Receive forgiveness because Jesus has promised to forgive you. → **Testify** of Jesus (tell others about Him).

**Remember:** we are talking to Jesus when we pray
