Mark 10:31

"But many *who are* first will be last, and the last first."

Lord Jesus, please help me understand what it means to be first in your kingdom. Help me to live in such a way that I can be first.

Matt 5:3

"Blessed are the poor in spirit

Lord God, help me to lean upon you and to see just how poor in spirit I am; how much I need you. Thank you Lord, for blessing those who are poor in spirit.

Matt 5:4

Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted

Lord I am not as close to you as I could be; please help me to repent over my sin. Thank you for your comfort when I am sad because of my sin.

Mark 5:5

Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth

Lord, I choose humility, help me to be meek. Help me to understand what meekness means in my own life. Thank you for the reward you give the meek.

1 Sam 16:7

Man looks on the outward appearance, but the Lord looks on the heart.

Thank you Lord; you see all the thoughts and choices in my heart and still you love me. Please help me Lord, so that the words of my mouth and the thoughts of my heart are pleasing to you.

Help me to see myself as you see me and others as you see them.
